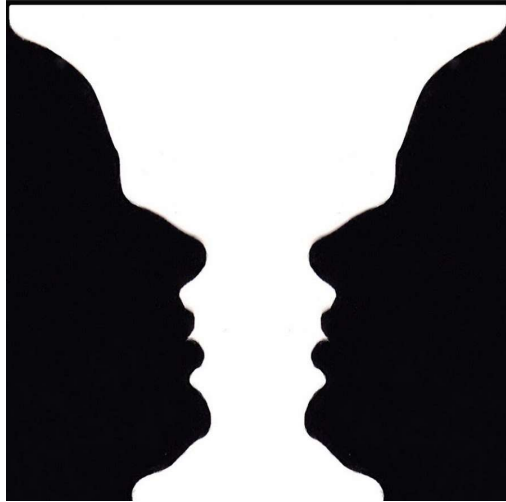


The Divine Paradoxes
