

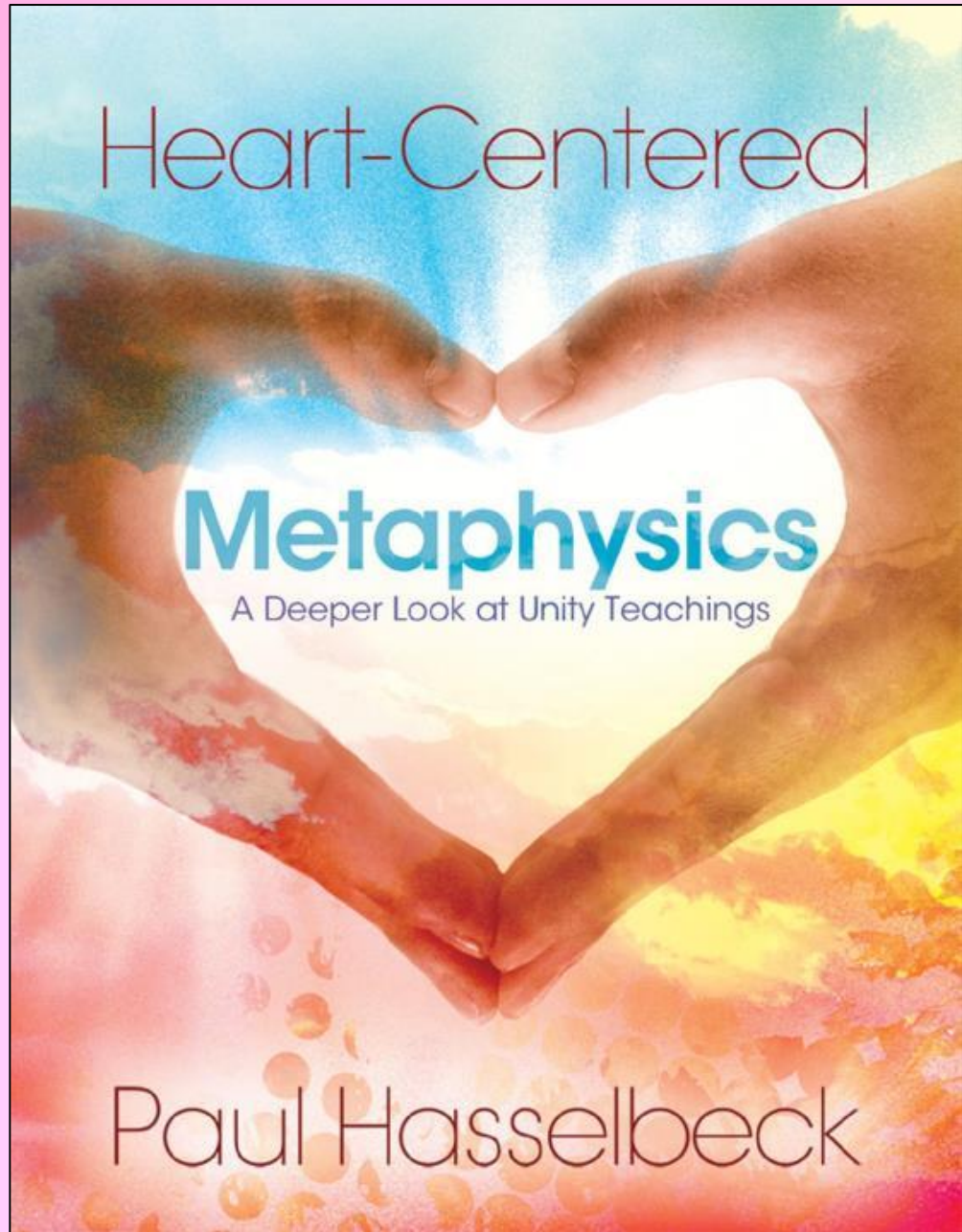

When is Easter?

The First Sunday
after the first
Paschal Full
Moon after the
Ecclesiastical
Equinox



When is Easter (Part 1)

- 1. Ecclesiastical equinox:** Always March 21 (regardless of actual or astronomical spring equinox)
- 2. Paschal Full Moon:** Always 14th Day of the Lunar Month (regardless of actual date of full moon)

When is Easter (Part 2)

3. First Sunday: after first Lunar Month Day 14 after March 21

Results:

- March 22 – April 25 (Western)
- April 3 – May 10 (Eastern Orthodox)

Mark 1:14-15 (NRSVUE)

When? “... Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the good news of God and saying, ‘The time is fulfilled, and the **kingdom of God** has come near (*sometimes translated is at hand*); repent, and believe in the good news.’”

Mark 4:30-32 (NRSVUE)

What? “He also said, ‘With what can we compare the **kingdom of God**, or what parable will we use for it? It is like a mustard seed, which, when sown upon the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth, yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes the greatest of all shrubs and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade.’”

Matthew 13:33 (NRSVUE)

Where? “He told them another parable: ‘The **kingdom of heaven** is like yeast that a woman took and mixed in with three measures of flour until all of it was leavened.’”

The Fourth Dimension

Three-dimensional world:

1. Length
2. Breadth
3. Thickness

4. Realization, doing away with time, space, and all conditions (encompasses first three dimensions)
